Meeting in Belgrade

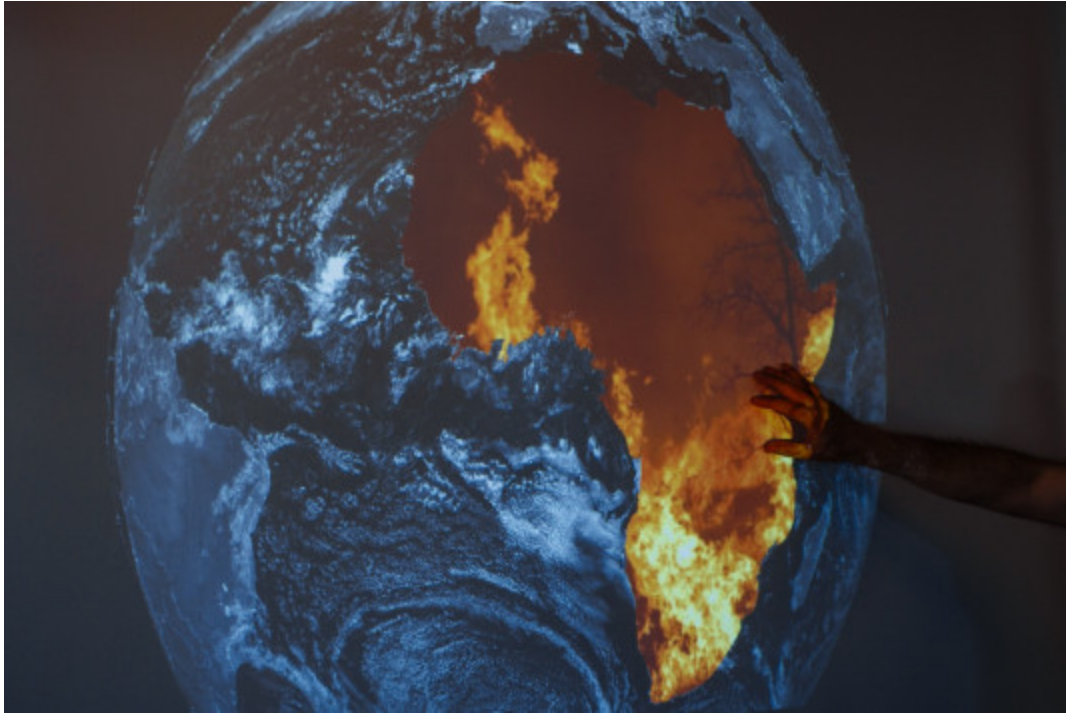
