


TNT

TNT, a theater research center that received the National Theater Award in 2008, is embarking on its seventh European project, TREES—an initiative led by DAH Teatre of Serbia, involving partners from seven different countries.

As the sole Spanish representative in the project, TNT plays a key role in promoting ecological and environmental awareness through the performing arts.

Running from early 2024 to late 2025, the project's main objective is to foster environmental awareness among the public, using dance, theater, and the performing arts as tools for social transformation.

Since its founding in 2012, AndanZas has developed a distinct style.

Its works bear a hallmark of quality and originality, each possessing its own charisma and an element of risk. The company is consistently committed to researching and exploring new artistic languages.

AndanZas' style is characterized by minimalism, precise control and mastery of movement within the stage space, the integration of physical action into the dramaturgical context, and the use of only essential objects in the interpretation of movement.


The company's dramaturgical contribution and the acting within its dance performances stand out, with its artistic value evident in every production.

SYNOPSIS

In a world where human greed ravages nature, trees endure. Arboreal Resistance is a performance that gives voice to these silent giants, exploring their struggle against time, deforestation, and oblivion. Among their roots dwell ancient echoes—perhaps the voices of the xanas, guardians of the forests, who still murmur their laments through the leaves.

Ethereal and elusive, the xanas protect nature's secrets yet suffer its destruction. It is said that when a tree is uprooted or a river is polluted, their wailing echoes through the thicket, warning us before it is too late.

Through dance, song, and music, the performers embody the strength, fragility, and memory of the forests, revealing their resilience and will to survive. A theatrical ritual that confronts us with a haunting question: Is humanity their ally or their destroyer?
